Mathematics tasks	Learn Odd and Even numbers to 10		
	Practise your doubles up to 5		
	Find out what your families favourite healthy snacks are. Ask them ' <u>Beth wyt ti'n hoffi?</u> ' <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• What was the most popular snack?</li> <li>• What was the least popular snack?</li> <li>• How did you record your information?</li> <li>• How many people did you ask altogether?</li> <li>• How many were boys? How many were girls?</li> </ul>		
	<u>RECEPTION</u> Practise 2 more and 2 less up to 10. Can you write it as a number sentence?		
	<u>YEAR 1</u> Practise place value using teen numbers. 17 = 1 ten and 7 units ( $10 + 7 = 17$ )		
	Take part in some cooking or baking activities with who you live with as long as it is safe. Learn to weigh ingredients using different equipment. Measure the time it takes to cook or prepare something. What did you do? Did you enjoy it?		
Literacy	<u>RECEPTION</u> Continue to practise reading, recognising and forming all your Speed Sound Set 1 in your Reading Folders. Keep your red words on the boil.		

	<u>YEAR 1</u> Continue to practise reading, recognising and forming all your Speed Sound Set 1 and 2. Use Youtube to learn Speed Sounds Set 3.		
	Read your favourite story. Change the main character and retell the story again. For example 'Little Red Riding Hood' -You could change the character to Mini Green Galloping Hood, or you could change the wolf to a Lion or Tiger. Have fun 😊		
	The season is changing. Spring is now here. Write a list of all the signs that tell us Spring has come.		
	Write a list of rhyming words to match these words. bat                fog                path ball                tin                fit		
	Learn opposites For example hard / soft, hot/cold  How many can you write down?		
	Draw a picture of something special you did with your family during our #stayhome time. Write a sentence to explain why it was so special.		
Topic Tasks	Our Summer Term topic is... <u>'How can we help you?'</u> Draw a mind map and write down ideas of what this title means to you. (How do we get help? Who helps us? How do they help? Is it only people who need help?)

thing; What would it be? Why?

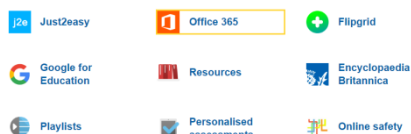
There are lots of people in our community that need to be helped in different ways. What could we do as a class to help and support our local community?

If you had a job that helped people what would it be?

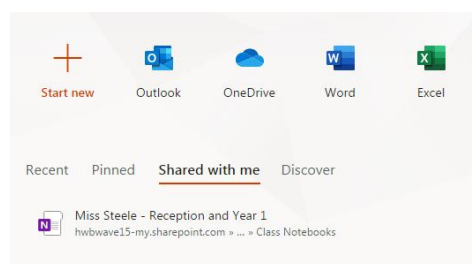
What skills could you learn in school to help you become successful?
